The Woods Family Nurse Practitioner Bursary Application

Deadline for applications is on October 17, 2025.**

Late submissions will not be accepted.

The Woods Family Nurse Practitioner Bursary is an education award designed to provide funding for nurse practitioners working in oncology and hematology at Juravinski Hospital and Cancer Centre. The Bursary is intended to enhance the ability of nurse practitioners to provide comprehensive, person-centered integrated care to individuals with cancer and their families across the care continuum.

The bursary will be awarded annually in the amount of \$2,000 and staff supported through this bursary are expected to share their skills with their colleagues at JHCC and to make academic presentations of their work.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Your application must include:

1. A COMPLETED APPLICATION FORM

2. LETTER OF SUPPORT

- ✓ One (1) letter of support composed of direct Supervisor/Manager and Program Head/Director. Additional letters of support can be submitted as appropriate [e.g. Disease Site Team Chair].

3. PROOF OF COMPLETION

- ✓ Applicants must provide proof of enrolment or acceptance in a college or university undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree program or registration in an approved continuing education program.
- ✓ A copy of course description and proof of successful completion is required.

Only applications that include the above elements will be considered.

CRITERIA AND CONDITIONS

Criteria:

- ✓ Applicants must be nurse practitioners or registered nurses enrolled in a nurse practitioner program and are currently working in Oncology & Hematology at Juravinski Hospital and Cancer Centre.

Conditions:

1. Staff supported through this bursary are expected to:
 - ✓ share their skills and learnings with their colleagues at JHCC and to make academic presentations of their work.
 - ✓ Submit a written impact report to Hamilton Health Sciences Foundation, summarizing how the bursary has benefited them academically and clinically in pursuing their career as a Nurse Practitioner. The report should be submitted within 30 days of program completion.
2. Reimbursements will be issued after the successful completion of the course by submitting all detailed expense receipts, transcripts, etc.
